*[South Carolina](#) requires “at least one (1) hour of ACPE continuing education regarding administration of immunizations for pharmacists who administer immunizations”; however, the [PREP Act](#) currently requires “licensed pharmacist must complete a minimum of two (2) hours of ACPE-approved, immunization-related continuing pharmacy education during each State licensing period”.

†[South Carolina](#) requires at least one (1) hour of ACPE continuing education must be related to “approved procedures for monitoring controlled substances” (with a purpose of combatting the opioid epidemic).

‡[South Carolina](#) requires that fifty percent (7.5 hours) of the total number of required hours (15 hours) must be in drug therapy or patient safety.
