Objectives:

Patient Safety: Medication Error Reporting (9:10am - 10:10am) ***(ACPE UAN 0062-9999-19-038-L05-T, 0.1 CEUs)***

At the completion of this activity, the participant will be able to:

- Discuss the importance of reporting medication errors
- List the most common types of medication errors
- Identify strategies to minimize the most common medication errors made by pharmacy technicians.

Pharmacy Law: Pain and Controlled Substances (10:10am - 11:10am) ***(ACPE UAN 0062-9999-19-039-L03-T, 0.1 CEUs)***

- Outline goals for acute and chronic pain management

- Identify product composition, including supplemental fact labeling and associated terminology
