

In partnership with Mid-Carolina AHEC, the South Carolina Immunization Coalition has partnered with leading researchers from the University of South Carolina and Duke University to host a series of trainings during which SC professionals can learn and practice core skills of motivational interviewing.

Course Objectives

- Describe basic principles of Motivational Interviewing (MI)
- Demonstrate core skills of MI, including open-ended questions, affirmations, reflective listening, and summarizing (OARS skills)
- Identify best practices in implementing MI to promote uptake of recommended immunizations
- Define 'stages of change' and explain MIbased strategies appropriate for each stage
- Discriminate between change talk and sustain talk
